REACH Substances of Very High Concern (SVHC) Declaration for Iridium Subscriber Products

Under Article 33 of EU REACH Regulation 1907/2006 and its amendment regulations, including PFOA/PFOS, Iridium Satellite LLC (Iridium) has a duty to communicate to our customers the presence of SVHCs in excess of 0.1% by weight of articles contained in our products.

Iridium reviewed the following transceiver products for the presence of the two hundred and one (201) SVHC substances on the EU SVHC Candidate List as of 16 July 2019.
